# RABIES

## **WHAT IS RABIES?**

Rabies is a fatal but preventable viral disease. It can spread to people and pets if they are bitten or scratched by a rabid animal. In the United States, rabies is mostly found in wild animals like bats, raccoons, skunks, and foxes.



# TAKE ACTION!

Remember that rabies is a medical urgency but not an emergency.

If you've been in contact with any wildlife or unfamiliar animals, particularly if you've been bitten or scratched, you should talk with a healthcare or public health professional to determine your risk for rabies or other illnesses.

#### BE CAUTIOUS.

- 1.LEAVE WILDLIFE ALONE!
- 2. Wash ALL bites and scratches immediately with water and soap.
- 3. Know the risks: **bats and skunks** are most commonly positive in our area for rabies.





## BE PREPARED.

Domesticated animals can get rabies too!

Keep your pets up to date on their rabies vaccine, and be aware of unknown animals like neighborhood cats and other unknown domesticated animals.
